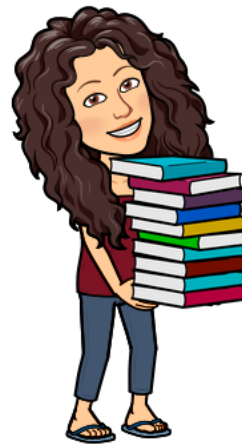


HOOVER MEDIA CENTER

7,269 PRINT BOOKS CHECKED OUT

This is up from 4,036 books circulated last school year (+44%)

Top Title: *Becoming Muhammad Ali* by Kwame Alexander & James Patterson (52)

2nd Top Title: *Cleo Porter and the Body Electric* by Jake Burt (50)

Books in our collection: **9,779**

749 E-BOOKS CHECKED OUT

This was our fourth year with Sora (Overdrive), which allows Hoover's students access to eBooks and audiobooks 24/7 from anywhere. Usage increased by 51% (or 362 checkouts) this year. I tried to heavily promote eBooks with the faculty and students, especially to access SSYRA and Lightbox titles.

25,629.1 ACCELERATED READER POINTS EARNED

This is up from 14,442.4 A.R. points earned in the last school year (+44%).

540 students participated, **78%** average questions correct, **44.5** average points per student.

605 CLASSES SERVED

The number of class periods that Mrs. Woodbrey was working with a class of students and collaborating with teachers on research, maker space challenges, literacy promotion, and digital and information literacy. Collaborated with **6** Departments.

416 20 BOOK CHALLENGE ENTRIES

2 Students finished & 11 students completed at least ten or more entries for the 20 Book Challenge.
62 Students participated.
