



Pursuant to House Bill 1069 (2023), each district school board shall adopt and publish on its website the process for a parent or guardian to limit his or her student's access to materials in the school or classroom library.

Brevard Public School Library Access

Parents or guardians have the right to limit their child's access to materials in the school or classroom library by completing a Limited Access form (available upon request or on the school website) and returning it to their child's school. Instructional materials are not included in this Limited Access form.

The parental/guardian limitation will remain effective until the parent/guardian requests to revert to unlimited access.
