




#### Q5 Do you feel welcome at your child's school?








# Q7 Following this year's health and safety protocols, how often did you attend a parent meeting or event at your child's school that supported your child's academic success?

#### Q8 When is the best time for you to attend a school event for families?








# Q12 What types of family engagement resources would you use if they were provided at your school?







#### Q13 How often do you communicate with your child's teachers?





# Q14 How often does your child's teacher communicate with you about your child's progress?





# Q15 Are you satisfied with the relationship and communication you currently have with your child's principal?





### Q17 How often does your child's school or teachers provide you with information about ways you can help your child's learning at home?










### Q24 Are you aware of the four choice elementary schools?







#### Q25 Have you visited the Open Enrollment Parental Choice webpage?






# Q27 Do you use the school or district website to find information about your child's education?
