- A copy of your student's last FAST scores that you have for Reading and Math. If you do not have FAST scores, please use I-Ready scores or your last standardized test scores.
- A copy of your last report card
- Please include two of your current teachers' names and email addresses, so the teacher recommendation link can be sent to their emails.

Please write the student's name and student I.D. number, parent's name, parent's email address, preferred phone number, and home address on <u>a cover page that is attached to all paperwork.</u> (essay, FAST/standardized test scores, most recent report card, and your two current teachers' names/email addresses).
