Class Schedule

- Setting up a class schedule is optional!
- You can set a default class duration (1-120 mins)
- Set up your class schedule for the times that you meet
 - **Important** - You will still need to sign in to Aristotle from Launchpad for the schedule to start

⌚ Default Class Duration

The default class length can be anywhere from 1 to 120 minutes. This setting does not take effect if the class has a defined schedule for any day of the week. This input is optional and can be left blank if you do not wish to have students join your classroom automatically.

Note: If this is left blank, you will still be able to force the students into your class once it starts.

📅 Scheduled Class Sessions

Setting a per-day schedule will cause the class to automatically start at the specified start time each day. When the class is started, all students will automatically join your class. Note: If there is a schedule set for at least one day of the week then the "Default Class Length" setting has no effect.

Send an emailed report that contains a list of all users that were in your class.

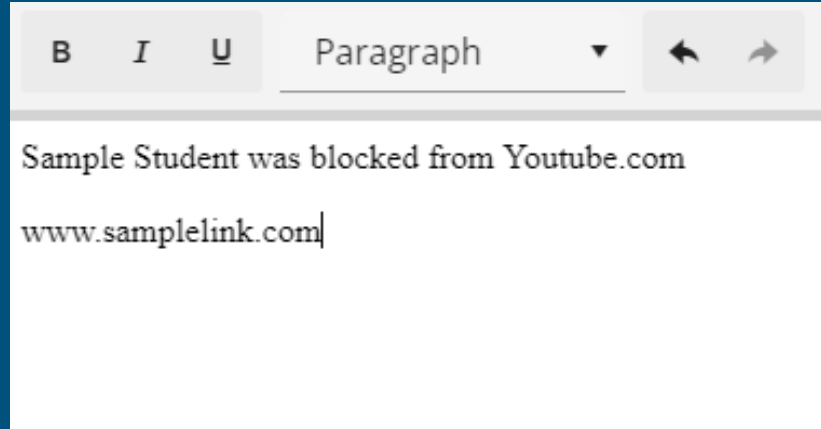


Detailed Activity Report

Send an emailed report that contains detailed activity for each user during your class period. This requires you to setup the Class Schedule below and reports will be based on normal class hours.

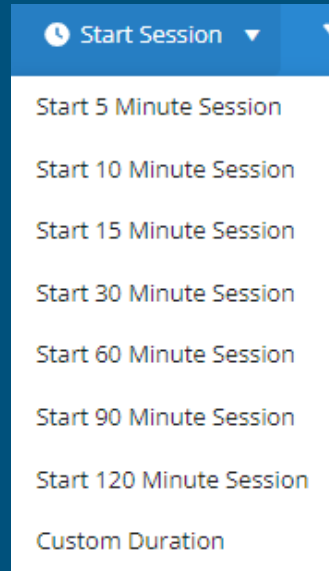
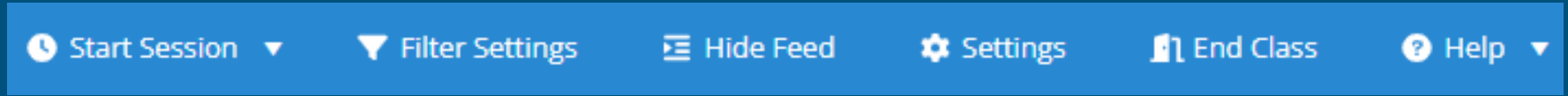

Individual Student View

- **Tabs** - view student's opened tabs
 - **Open Site** - enter a URL and open a tab for the student

 - FortiGuard - District Firewall



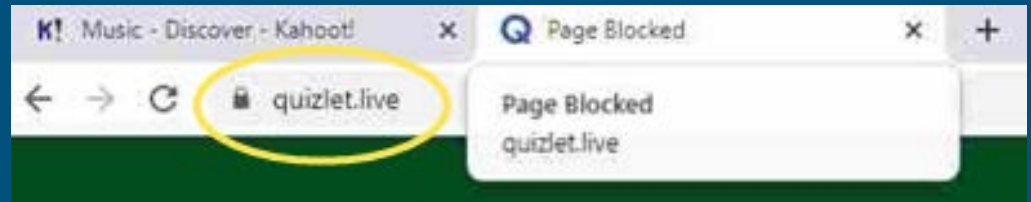
