#### **Approval of Minutes**

## **Open Business**

- 1. Professional Learning Community Presentation
  - a. PLC Team 5 presented with a focus on student behavior in grades K-3. The team discussed ways to get students to adhere to the Lockmar ARMOR code of conduct including individual student contracts and behavior plans, student check-ins with mentor adults, student surveys, teaching coping skills and self-regulation, expressing emotions through drawing, providing outreach to parents, and rewards / incentives such as lunch in the classroom, free choice activities and classroom parties.

#### 2. SAC Budget

a. Current budget: \$5,725.75. This amount reflects a deduction of \$355 for the Future Problem Solving team registration. \$15 of this will be reimbursed from internal funds to cover the cost of a T-Shirt which was included in the purchase price.
