SAC Minutes 1/17/24 -4:15 PM in the Media Center

- 1. Ruth Singer called the meeting to order at 4:15 PM
- 2. Attendance and determination of a quorum by- Ruth Singer
 - Eddy Lynn Kledzik, Ruth Singer, Jess Hopkins, Sheryl Brown, Danielle Hausmann, Megan Pace, Dave
 Reasland, Wyatt Stumbo, Cari Smith, Cristina Smith, Ariel Prohaska
- 3. Ruth Singer called for the Adoption of Agenda which was motioned by Wyatt Stumbo, 2nd by Danielle Hausmann, and all in favor.
- 4. Ruth Singer called for Adoption of the November Minutes which was motioned by Sheryl Brown, 2nd by Megan Pace, and all in favor.
- 5. New Business -
 - Eddy Lynn Kledzik shared information about School Recognition Funds. Longleaf will be awarded an estimated amount of \$95,458 to \$107,776. 59 of the Longleaf employees who are eligible for the reward took a survey to provide input. The survey questions were:
 - Option 1 100% Nonrecruiting bonuses to faculty and staff.
 - Option 2 100% towards educational equipment or materials to assist in maintaining or improving student performance (nonrecurring)
 - Option 3 Split between nonrecurring bonus to faulty and staff and educational equipment or material. (Percentage of split to be determined by future vote.)
 - Survey answers were:
 - Option 1 selected by 48 people
 - Option 1 with a note added -prorated for hours worked (i.e. 4 hours, 5.5 hours, 8 hours,) -1
 - Option 2 selected by 1 person
 - Option 3 selected by 3 people
 - Option 4 write in option submitted by 6 people "100% nonrecurring bonuses to faculty
 and staff with 60% to instructional staff based on weekly hours worked. 40% to support
 staff based on weekly hours worked.
 - Discussion by SAC of all options with the following results.
 - Option 1 put on ballot as is

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- Option 1 with the note be included on the ballot.
- Option 2 leave off the ballot.
- Option 3 leave off the ballot.
- Option 4 SAC does not think this in in the best interest of the instructional staff who played the role of earning the bonus. Instructional staff is 45/64 of the eligible recipients on the list which is 70%. If instructional staff receives 60% of the allotted monies, they are taking a cut lower than they represent. 19/64 eligible recipients represent the support staff which is 29%. Support staff would be receiving a much larger portion of the reward.
- SAC suggests the following ballot:
 - Option 1 100% Nonrecurring bonuses to faculty and staff equally split between all eligible.
 - Option 2 100% Nonrecurring bonuses to faculty and staff equally split between all eligible,
 prorated for hours worked. (Contract hours)
