



Children born between February 2 and September 1 of the calendar year may postpone VPK enrollment until the following school year when the child will be 5 years old.

  - b. Parent Portal link will allow access to the registration website
- 3. The Parent Portal main page has 3 options:
  - Returning Parents Sign in Parent already has an Email and Password to sign in to their account
  - b. Existing Parents Sign In If your child(ren) are currently attending a BAS Program or have attended in the past but you do not yet have a password, you will click a link to receive a temporary password by email. Your email should already be set-up.
  - c. New Parents Open Account have never had a child in our programs
- Once you register, you may continue to enroll for the Summer-Full Time program for your child(ren). If you are looking for other options, please see your site coordinator.
- Upon completion of online registration, you will need to print the 1) <u>BPS Opt</u>
   <u>Out/Photo Release</u> form and the 2) <u>Summer Camp Discipline and Toy Policy</u> form,
   found under <u>Parent Forms</u> on our website. Complete and submit to the Site
   Coordinator.
- 6. Provide a current picture of your child(ren) to the Site Coordinator.
- Field trips and activities will be available for online reservation prior to the start of the summer programs. Please remember: All additional activities must be reserved by Thursday of the week prior to scheduled activity.

Activity fees must be paid for at the that time of reservation and are non-refundable.



DEADLINE: April 22, 2024

New Applications: If you have an incoming Kindergarten student or any NEW incoming student that is out of Longleaf's School Zone, you must complete the following steps to be entered into the LOTTERY:

Step 1: Create a New Application for the 2024-2025 School Year, for your incoming student, in the Family Dashboard https://brevardflc.scriborder.com/family to be entered into the LOTTERY.



Step 2: Pick up a Paper Enrollment Packet from the Front Desk at Longleaf to fill out and turn in. The LOTTERY will be held on MAY 3rd, if you are offered a seat you will need to go into your Family Dashboard to ACCEPT it by no later than May 24th.

Lunch Bunch is an opportunity for families to have lunch in school with their students. This program is available on Thursdays and supervised by our approved BPS volunteers or school designees. The families of our Bobcats are asked to limit sign up to once a month to provide opportunities to all our families. The following procedures are followed to maintain safety on campus.

Come at your student's designated time. We will not call students out of class early.
 Sign-in at the front office with proper ID and get a badge.
 Visitors will be escorted to our designated "Bobcat Lunch Bunch" area located in the

Commons.

4. Students will be brought to/from the lunch area by our volunteer staff. 5. Visitors will check out in the front office when their student is picked up by the teacher. If you have multiple students, you will need to check out and check back in at their designated time as we do not have a waiting area.

Safety Reminders:

Parents/guests may not enter the cafeteria or go through the lunch line. Contacts on the student registration form are allowed to eat with the students. The contact may bring an additional guest with them. Other classmates will not be allowed to join your student for lunch.

Outside food will remain with the parents as well as any leftovers. Parents also have the option of checking their students out and taking them off campus for lunch.

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





