



- <u>Arrival-</u> Early arrival is a major safety issue. There is <u>no supervision</u> before 7:30 am. Please do not drop off your students prior to 7:30 as they are not being monitored. This also pertains to walkers/bikers. Longleaf before/after care is available for a fee if you have a need. Please contact the front office for more information.
- <u>Dismissal-</u> As a reminder everyone is required to have a car tag in order to receive your student(s) when walking up to the front of the building. If you are not a resident of the apartment complex, Longleaf Preserves, you are asked to use the Longleaf car loop or park in our campus parking lots for dismissal and arrival. We cannot escort kindergarten students down to the gate and release them nor can we walk students off campus. This procedure is to ensure student safety. If you would like to request car tags, you will need to come to the front office with proper identification. Car tags will only be given to the custodial parents. Please remember that anytime a transportation method is changed, you will need to follow the below procedures.
 - <u>Request for Change in Transportation Plans</u>- Students must bring a note from home if using a different method of transportation or going to a different destination at dismissal time. Transportation changes will never be taken over the phone. If a student is enrolled in Longleaf After Care, it is the parent's responsibility to notify the classroom teacher, as well as Longleaf After Care when transportation plans have been changed.
- <u>Car Riders-</u> Please leave your car tag visible until you have secured your student(s) in your vehicle. The teachers at the lanes need to know what student(s) they are putting in the car. We appreciate your help in a safe and speedy dismissal.

Thank you for your help and cooperation in ensuring a safe and efficient arrival and dismissal.



Free or Low-Cost Health and Dental Insurance for Kids

Your child and their siblings could be one of the 179,000 children eligible for completely free or low-cost health and dental insurance through Florida KidCare – even if one or both parents are working.

Approximately 2.3 million children rely on Florida KidCare for the head-to-toe coverage they need from birth through the end of age 18. Florida KidCare is designed to provide services to children at each stage of growth and development. Health and dental services are delivered through quality plans that offer a choice of local doctors, dentists, specialists, hospitals, pharmacies and other health care providers.

- Surgeries
- Check-ups

- Vision & Hearing
- PrescriptionsEmergencies
- Dental Care

- Hospital Stays
 Mental Health Services

Florida KidCare includes free, subsidized and full-pay options based on family income and household size. Most families pay nothing at all for coverage, and many pay as little as \$15 or \$20 a month. Families who do not qualify for free or subsidized coverage may purchase a competitively priced full-pay plan.

Lawfully residing immigrant children are eligible without a waiting period, and information about a parent's immigration status won't be asked.

With no application fee and year-round enrollment, the time to apply is always now. Simply fill out the application, and Florida KidCare will match your child with the right option.
