Our induction ceremony will be on September 26, 2023 at 5:30pm in the Longleaf Café.







Lunch Bunch is an opportunity for families to have lunch in school with their students. This program is available on Thursdays and supervised by our approved BPS volunteers or school designees. The families of our Bobcats are asked to limit sign up to once a month to provide opportunities to all our families. The following procedures are followed to maintain safety on campus.

1. Come at your student's designated time. We will not call students out of class early. 2. Sign-in at the front office with proper ID and get a badge.

3. Visitors will be escorted to our designated "Bobcat Lunch Bunch" area located in the

Commons.

4. Students will be brought to/from the lunch area by our volunteer staff. 5. Visitors will check out in the front office when their student is picked up by the teacher. If you have multiple students, you will need to check out and check back in at their designated time as we do not have a waiting area.

Safety Reminders:
Parents/guests may not enter the cafeteria or go through the lunch line. Contacts on the student registration form are allowed to eat with the students. The contact may bring an additional guest with them. Other classmates will not be allowed to join your student for lunch.

Outside food will remain with the parents as well as any leftovers. Parents also have the option of checking their students out and taking them off campus for lunch.

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

• Arrival- Early arrival is a major safety issue! There is no supervision before 7:30 am. Please do not drop off your students prior to 7:30 as they are not being monitored. This also pertains to walkers/bikers arriving early on campus. Longleaf before/after care is available for a fee if you have a need. Please contact the front office for more information.

• Dismissal- As a reminder everyone is required to have a car tag to receive your student(s) when walking up to the front of the building. If you are not a resident of the apartment complex, Longleaf Preserves, you are asked to use the Longleaf car loop or park in our campus parking lots for dismissal and arrival. We cannot escort kindergarten students down to the gate and release them nor can we walk students off campus. This procedure is to ensure student safety. If you would like to request car tags, you will need to come to the front office with proper identification. Car tags will only be given to the custodial parents.

• Car Riders- Please leave your car tag visible until you have secured your student(s) in your vehicle. The teachers at the lanes need to know what student(s) they are putting in the car. We appreciate your help and cooperation to ensure a safe and speedy dismissal.

o We are asking parents to be courteous and mindful of the traffic laws when arriving for dismissal. Please refrain from blocking traffic and impeding others from entering the car loop or overflow parking lot. For safety purposes, we ask to refrain from use of cell phone in our car loop. Thank you for doing your part to make this a safe and efficient process for all!

If you have additional questions or concerns, please contact the front office.

Request for Change in Transportation Plans

Students must bring a note from home if using a different method of transportation or going to a different destination at dismissal time. Transportation changes will never be taken over the phone. If a student is enrolled in Brevard After School program, it is the parent's responsibility to notify the classroom teacher, as well as Brevard After School when transportation plans have been changed.
