### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Changing the way a child goes home **MUST be done in writing**. We must have a signed (parent or legal guardian), dated note to your child's teacher with the change (bus, walk, etc.) be sure to include the date(s) that the change will be in effect. **Changes can not be made over the phone, via email, text or messaging app, they can only be made in writing by the parent/legal guardian.**
- **FREE breakfast & lunch** every day for students! Breakfast is served from 7:30-7:55AM. Students should arrive by 7:45AM at the latest for breakfast so they have plenty of time to eat and get to class by 8:00AM.
- **Please be sure that your PreK, VPK, Kindergarten & 1st grade students pack an emergency change of clothing in a sealed baggie with their name on it** to use in case of an accident. We currently do not have extra clothing in the clinic. If a student needs a change and doesn't have any, we will have to call and have you bring some to school. Be sure to check their backpack daily for dirty clothes and replace them with clean clothing for the next time.
