





How to Apply to Melbourne High School's International Baccalaureate Programs

All students residing in Florida are eligible to apply to Melbourne High School's Choice International Programs: Diploma Program or Career Program, including students not zoned for Melbourne High School.

МАТН	 Incoming 9th grade students: Must have completed <u>Algebra I</u> for accelerated IB DP math progression; students complete Geometry and Algebra II before junior year IB DP math coursework. 	 For students enrolled at MHS: Do not require a minimum level of math to apply to any of the Career/Technical Education programs. Must complete math course progression required by the State of Florida for graduation.
FOREIGN LANGUAGE	 Incoming 9th grade students: MUST have at least one year of Spanish or French completed prior to August 1. FLVS (Florida Virtual School) offers these languages. Diploma students reach level 5 in foreign language junior or senior year for the IB exams. Students with no prior foreign language may be offered a seat with contingency to complete Spanish 1 or French 1 on FLVS by August 1st. 	 For students enrolled at MHS: Do not require a minimum level of foreign language to begin the program. May take any level foreign language during any of the four years in high school Will complete a foreign language portfolio as part of the Career Program in junior and senior years.
 Melbourne High School's IB Diploma Program prepares students for college/university and life through the Diploma Program coursework and unique high school course progression. Students who earn the IB Diploma automatically qualify for the Florida Academic Scholars Bright Futures Scholarship.
