THE FLAG

Types of flags:

Garrison flag: A garrison flag is a large US army flag that is flown on military posts on special days. This flag's measurements are 20 feet by 38 feet.

Post Flag: A post flag is a large US army flag that is ordinarily flown on military posts, with measurements of 8 feet 11 3/8 inches by 17 feet.

Storm Flag: A storm flag is a small US army flag that is flown on military posts during storms. Its measurements are 5 feet by 9.5 feet.
