




Q3 Does your child have access to a computer and internet connection outside of school?




Q5 Does your child's school keep you informed about information and events in a format that is easy to understand?





Q7 Do you feel welcome at your child's school?







Q9 Have you been given opportunities to provide input and feedback into school decisions (school improvement, Title I services, event planning, discipline)?





Q10 Do you feel your child's school values input from families?





Q12 What is the best way for you to provide input regarding your child's school?



Q13 In what ways can family engagement be strengthened at your child's school?



Q14 How often do you communicate with your child's teachers?





Q15 Are you aware of what your child is expected to master in all subject areas?





Q16 How often does your child's teacher communicate with you about your child's progress?





Q17 How many times per month do you access your child's grades through FOCUS?





Q18 How often do you have conversations with your child about what he or she is learning in school?





Q19 How often do you work with your child on homework or class assignments?





Q20 In the past year, how often have you participated in classroom activities during the school day?






Q22 Which of the following informational meetings and activities would you participate in or attend?



Q23 In the past year, how often did you attend a parent meeting or event at your child's school that supported your child's academic success?






