

2021-2022 COVID Protocols

When students are a contact to a case **and** are *asymptomatic*, parents have the option to have the student quarantine for up to 7 days or remain in school. Students who are positive for Covid **or** are exhibiting symptoms are required to: 1) Have a negative test **and** be asymptomatic, 2) Quarantine for 10 days, show an improvement in symptoms and have no fever for 24 hours unmedicated, or 3) Have written permission from a healthcare provider in order to return to school.

Please notify the main office should your child become ill or test positive for COVID-19, so that we can evaluate the situation and determine if further precautions or notifications are necessary.
