Storybook Character Parade

Join us for the Annual Character Book
Parade on October 26th. Students are encouraged
to choose a book character and come to school
dressed for the parade and carry their book
with them during the parade. We will be
meeting under the pavilion at 8:15am. Parents are
welcome to join us. Parents and younger siblings are
encouraged to participate with a costume depicting their
favorite storybook character. Everyone in costume will
walk the track under the pavilion!

Remember, your child's costume should relate to a published book; no scary costumes, masks, or weapons allowed. This is the only day children may dress up in costumes. In the Elementary Student Handbook, the dress code reads, "Extreme hairstyles, hair colors, or make-up that is disruptive or does not allow direct eye contact is prohibited." If non-natural colored hair is a major feature of the story book character, please consider a wig, clip in extensions or option other than dye or spray on color.



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Ocean Breeze is using the electronic flyer communication tool called "Peachjar." To view school-approved e-flyers, simply click the Peachjar button on the school's website. This "green" initiative will save our schools tons of paper and reduce copy costs by thousands of dollars.

No action is required on your part. You will receive a welcome email from our service provider (Peachjar) that includes a username and password. This is provided to give you the opportunity to manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. You do not need to login to receive or view school eflyers.

To ensure smooth delivery of this communication, we suggest you add bpsflyers@peachjar.com to your email contacts. When you receive your first e-flyer, be sure to click "always display images."

This system is used exclusively for distribution of school-approved flyers. Your email address will not be shared or used for any other purpose. Thank you for supporting our efforts to ensure parents are well informed about school programs, activities, and events.

Rainy Day Plans

Every family should have a "rainy day" plan for school dismissal and make arrangements for walkers and bike riders in the event of a storm. As we know, these storms may take several hours to clear. Parents may either make arrangements to pick up their child, have a neighbor pick up the student, or arrange for Dolphin Cove to take the student on rainy days only. Please remember, if anyone other than the parent is picking up a child, they must be on the release card that was completed the first week of school. If you need to add a name to your child's release card, please stop by the office. Also, if you want to take advantage of the services of Dolphin Cove, you must complete the registration process before they can attend. It is extremely helpful that your child know what they are suppose to do, so they do not need to call home or call parents at work.

School Procedures:

1. If it is raining without any sign of lightning, we will dismiss car loop and bus students.

- 2. We will hold our walkers and bike riders until the rain has slowed to the point where we have confidence students can arrive home safely and not soaked to the bone.
- If there is lightning in the vicinity, we will <u>NOT DISMISS ANY</u> student from the classroom.
- Parents who come through the car loop may choose to park and pick up their child in the classroom. We would not recommend this but will not prevent a parent from assuming responsibility for their child's safety.
 - 5. Staff will not be outside during a lightning storm.
