The Education Location Option (ELO), formally known as Out of Area, application window opens May 1, 2019. Parents who wish for their child to attend a school other than the zoned school for attendance must complete an online application and a \$30 application fee between May 1 and June 7, 2019.

Students currently attending Ocean Breeze on an ELO must complete a **RENEWAL** application if they wish to remain here for 2019-2020 school year.

May 1-2	4th-6th Grade - ELA
May 7-8	3rd-6th Grade - Math
May 9-10	5th Grade - Science



Students may not be checked out of school if they are in a testing session. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time, so they do not have to wait until a make-up session to complete the FSA. Thank you for your support.
