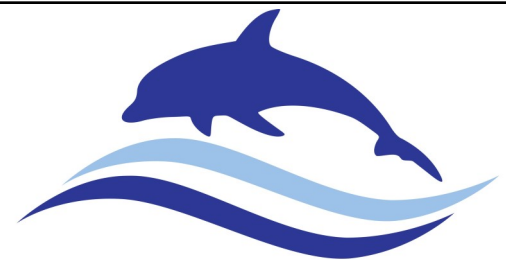

Arrival/Dismissal

Just a reminder: Arrival begins at **7:30AM** to ensure students are in their classrooms promptly at **8:00AM**. Students who are not in their classroom at 8:00AM are being marked tardy. Please adjust your drop off schedules to **arrive by 7:50AM** to ensure students are in class at 8:00AM.

For safety purposes, students should exit vehicles on the right side of the car (closest to building). Please do not exit your vehicles for drop off, as this poses a safety hazard and impedes loop traffic.


Important Parent Information
