Meeting was called to order by Shelley Michaud on Friday, June 5, 2020 at 10:00AM via Skype.

- 1) Should we return in August? 2 responses- 100% return in Aug.- parent choice to send; 5- return in Aug. with modifications to current practice; 1- return 2nd semester; 2- need more info to make determination.
- 2) If can't guarantee 6 ft social distancing...

Transportation- alternating seats, sanitizing after each run, not as big an issue for OBE (3 buses)-how will be separate students during arrival & dismissal.

Cafeteria- Eat in rooms, staggered seating, less grades in cafeteria at once, set times not rotating

Class Change- teachers move, intermediate grades self-contained for 1 yr.

Unified Arts- Music, SEL, media, art "on a cart"- sanitizing before and after, 2 sets of PE equipment (one sanitized and sits during class, then rotated every other class).

- 3) What other concerns does team have? Plan for medically fragile students; medically fragile staff or immediate family?; will masks be required? provided? for students & staff?; will Dolphin Cove be open (BAS)?; how will we maintain social distancing with kindergarten students?; how much educational time will be swallowed up by protocols; will visitors be limited? exposure to volunteers, etc...; limiting visitors- what impact will it have on engagement?; how will recess work?
- 4) Suggestions: older kids (4-6) distance learning/PK-3 on site- lower class size; alternating days; hands cleaned/sanitized after each transition; temperature checks every 3 hours/health screenings; monitor ill attendance; limit group gatherings/events; teach & reinforce good hygiene; regular communication to families regarding illnesses; protocols for sick child at school; intensify cleaning & disinfecting.
