In our regular collaboration with the Indian Harbour and Satellite Beach Police Departments, we have been made

aware of increasing incidents of concern stemming from issues occurring with our students (primarily upper grades) in the evening and on weekends at local recreation areas (e.g. Gleason Park, athletic fields, tennis courts, etc...). These incidents range from the use of foul language to property destruction, physical altercations, etc...

As you begin making appointments for your child in April and May, please try to avoid the following Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) testing dates:

April 6 4th-6th Grade - FSA Writing April 6 -7 3rd Grade - FSA Reading May 4-5 4th-6th Grade - FSA Reading May 11-12 3rd-6th Grade - FSA Math May 18-19 5th Grade - Science



Students may not be checked out of school if they are in a testing session. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time, so they do not have to wait until a make-up session to complete the FSA. Thank you for your support.

Reminder

Walkers/bike riders should not arrive on campus until 7:30AM. when the gates open.

We have seen an increase in cases and close contact to cases in recent days. Please monitor students for symptoms and keep them home if not feeling well. Students who become ill at school will be sent to the clinic for an assessment. Per CDC & FL Department of Health guidance, if they exhibit one or more of the symptoms (see below), we will require your child to:

- 1) Stay home for 10 days,
- 2) Have a medical release from a licensed physician clearing them to return to school or
- 3) Have a negative **PCR** (not a rapid) Covid-19 test AND be without fever (100.4) for at least 24 hours without medication, in order to return to school.

When your child returns to school, all required documentation must be brought to the main office. We will review the information and give your child a pass back into class.

BPS is only accepting the viral/PCR test. Please be sure to check with the testing location to ensure the correct test is administered. The FLDOH building, in Viera, has transitioned to vaccine distribution and is no longer performing Covid-19 tests at that site.

Symptoms:

- Fever greater than 100.4
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Nausea or vomiting

- Headache
- Sore Throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Muscle or body aches
