It's hard to believe we are already nearing the end of the first nine weeks. (quarantine due to Covid-19 or exposure is considered excused).

#### **Health Update**

BPS has sent out messages pertaining to the new Covid-19 flow charts per FL Department of Education. Please note that the protocols for quarantining asymptomatic close contacts to positive cases has changed. Parents have the option to send asymptomatic close contacts to school or have them stay home for 7 days from the last exposure to the positive case.

The process, however for students exhibiting symptoms remains in place. Students who are symptoms (see below) need to: 1) Stay home for 10 days (no fever for 24 hrs without fever reducing medication & symptoms have improved, 2) Have a negative test, or 3) Receive written permission from a healthcare provider to return to school.

Fever (100.4 or higher) Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing Muscle/body aches New loss of taste/smell Nausea/vomiting

Chills Cough Headache Sore throat Diarrhea
