Education Location Option (ELO) April 30, 2021 - June 4, 2021

Families that attend Ocean Breeze Elementary on an ELO, will need to renew between April 30-June 4. If you have moved outside of our attendance boundaries and wish to remain at Ocean Breeze, parents must complete the online application and a \$30 fee between April 30-June 4. FSA Testing Schedule Window

As you begin making appointments for your child in May, please try to avoid the following Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) testing dates:

May 4-5	4th-6th Grade - FSA Reading
May 11-12	3rd-6th Grade - FSA Math
May 18-19	5th Grade - Science

Students may not be checked out of school if they are in a testing session. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time, so they do not have to wait until a make-up session to complete the FSA. Thank you for your support.

Per the Florida Department of Education (FDOE), no remote administrations are available for any statewide summative assessments. Therefore, we have created the following schedule to accommodate e-learner testing on campus:

Students will arrive between 7:50-7:59AM through the car loop and go directly to their teacher's classroom. We ask that e-learners bring a mask, water bottle, and snack. Testing will be begin at 8:30AM and will take approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes to 2 hours to complete. 3^{rd} grade students should be ready to be picked up at approximately 10:15AM and $4^{th}-6^{th}$ graders should be ready for pick-up at approximately 10:15AM. Please park in the front car loop, and Officer Jenn will bring your child to you when they have finished the assessment.
