<u>Student Instructional Hours</u> Monday through Thursday 7:55am to 2:30pm, Friday 7:55am to 1:15pm. Students may enter the building at 7:30am for breakfast.

Title I is a federal grant that ensures students have the opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and to reach proficiency on state standards and assessments. The primary focus of the Title I program is to support the students most at risk for academic failure. Title I provides supplemental funds to school districts to help schools with high concentrations of poverty to meet educational goals. Our School Improvement Plan (SIP) serves as our Title I Plan. The administration team collects data (including student assessment data) and feedback throughout the year from parents, teachers, and our School Advisory Council (SAC) to determine the goals for our SIP. The Title I budget is created to support the SIP goals. At PBE, Title I pays half of the salary of our Literacy Coach and the entire salary of our Math Coach, Science Lab Teacher, and Reading Interventionist. Some Title I funds are spent on family engagement and others on technology.

The Parent & Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) contains information on how Palm Bay Elementary School works with the community, volunteers, and business partnerships to increase student achievement. Title I schools provide training to both staff and parents, designed to increase student achievement and support family engagement. The plan describes how the school will carry out parent involvement requirements including developing the school-family compact for learning. The compact outlines the responsibilities of the student, parent, and teacher in striving to raise student achievement. Title I also ensures that parents/guardians receive information in an understandable language, hence translations for English Language Learners.

Florida's academic content standards establish high expectations for all students in the areas of reading, writing, science, and math. The BEST standards for ELA reading and math identify what students need to know. Cpalms.org is the state of Florida's official website for standards information. Title I families have the Right to Know teacher certification. PBE has a Title I binder located in the front office with this information. Title I schools ensure that parents are provided information regarding their child's achievement level on all state assessments, and PBE provides families with learning activities to help the student at home.

Stay informed about Title I by visiting Palm Bay Elementary School's website. Title I information can be found under the Faculty and Staff tab. For translation needs, click the icon in the top right hand corner and select the desired language.

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), requires that a Local Educational Agency prepare and disseminate an annual Local Educational Agency report card and provide information on state, local, and school performance and progress in an understandable and uniform format.

District and School grades provide an easily understandable way to measure the performance of a school. Parents and the public can use the grades and their components to understand how well each district and/or school is serving its students. District and school grades for the 2022-2023 school year serve as an Informational Baseline using the new assessment cut scores.

Adults interested in becoming a Brevard Public Schools Approved Volunteer must become approved by completing the application and fingerprinting process through Brevard Public Schools. The initial cost to become an approved volunteer is \$35. Act now! The fee is currently waived, but the District will again charge the initial \$35 at the end of this school year. There is an annual \$8 renewal fee. The online application for a VECHS Level II background check must be completed prior to fingerprinting. Brevard Public Schools has published a list of felony offenses that will disqualify applicants from eligibility. Fingerprinting must be completed at the BPS Educational Services Facility at the Office of District and School Security in Viera.

An applicant will be notified once approved to serve as a BPS Volunteer. Then, an approved applicant should alert Mrs.Miller at PBE of their volunteer status. Visit www.brevardschools.org/Page/11104 for additional information and a list of FAQs about the BPS volunteer application and fingerprinting process.
