PARKING

Student parking at Palm Bay Magnet High School is limited. The following guidelines will be in place regarding parking on campus:

- 1. Faculty and Staff will have first priority
- 2. Seniors will have second priority along with HOSA and Dual Enrollment students.
- 3. Extra-Curricular, school related activities will have third priority.
- 4. Juniors will have fourth priority.
- 5. Seniors will have an opportunity to obtain a parking permit on a first come, first served basis. The permits will go on sale at 8:00 a.m. on the day of senior registration.
- 6. The revoking of a parking permit will include, but is not limited to:
 - (1) Failure to maintain a GPA of 2.0 throughout the school year. There will be a check on the GPA at the end of each grading period.
 - (2) Discipline issues will be at the discretion of the administration.
 - (3) Absences nine or more in a semester, unexcused.
 - (4) More than six tardies to their first period class in one semester
 - (5) Committing traffic/driving violations on campus
 - (6) Transferring/selling of the parking permit

- 7. Parking Violations: Students parking illegally or parking without a parking sticker will follow PBHS's discipline sequence:
 - (1) First offense one day Saturday School
 - (2) Second and each additional offense one day out of school suspension
- 8. Temporary activity spots may be available for some extracurricular activities.
- 9. To purchase a permit students will be required to provide the following:
 - (1) Valid Driver's License
 - (2) Current Insurance
 - (3) Vehicle Registration must be in the name of the student purchasing the sticker or their parent/guardian.
- 10. No refunds will be issued if the student's parking privileges are revoked.
- 11.Students who are not issued a parking permit may be placed on a waiting list.
- 12. Parking for underclassmen will be limited. Underclassmen permits will be assigned on an available basis. Permits for underclassmen will be issued based on a requisition list that will be kept and made available through the Dean's office.
- 13. Parking usage will be monitored throughout the school year. Students who have permits, but do not utilize parking spaces on a regular basis are subject to a review to determine the need for such permit.

Please remember, safety is the number one concern at Palm Bay Magnet High.

Availability of student parking is subject to change. Administration reserves the right to alter any of the terms and conditions above based on the facts of the situation.
