TITLE I LEA PLAN, TITLE I LEA PFEP, TITLE I SCHOOL PFEP OR SIP) ARE NOT SATISFACTORY TO THE PARENTS OF PARTICIPATING CHILDREN, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL SUBMIT ANY PARENT COMMENTS WITH THE TITLE I, PART A PLAN WHEN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SUBMITS THE PLAN TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. PARENTS MUST BE INFORMED OF THEIR RIGHTS TO SUBMIT COMMENTS/CONCERNS.COMMENTS RECEIVED AT TITLE I SCHOOLS MUST BE FORWARDED TO THE DISTRICT TITLE I DEPARTMENT AND THOSE COMMENTS WILL BE INCLUDED WITH SUBMISSION OF THE LEA TITLE I PLAN, AS REQUIRED.

WHAT IS TITLE I?
