

## **Admission Requirements**

- ✓ Must be a public, private or home school secondary student in Brevard County
- ✓ Have an unweighted cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 for an Associate's Degree program
- ✓ Have an unweighted cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.5 for a certificate program
- ✓ Have college-ready reading and writing scores on the ACT, SAT and/or PERT



## **Getting Started**

- 1. **Qualify:** Meet with your school counselor to see if you qualify
- 2. **Apply:** Submit the Online Admission Application for Dual Enrollment
- 3. **Attend:** EFSC Dual Enrollment Orientation and submit your
  - Official high school transcript
  - EFSC application confirmation or acceptance
- Test: Schedule a PERT if you don't have ACT or SAT scores on file with EFSC
- Select Course(s): Complete the Dual Enrollment Registration form with your counselor
- 6. **Register:** Bring your signed form to EFSC and meet with an EFSC advisor to register

#### **A Dual Enrollment Option for Seniors**

Enjoy the best of both worlds your senior year! Become a full-time student at Eastern Florida through Early Admission but remain involved in sports and activities at your high school.

This year, over 500 early admission participants will have the opportunity to earn at least one year of college credit toward an Associate or Bachelor's degree, and many will have an A.A. when they graduate. Industry certification exams are also available at no cost to participants pursuing selected Associate in Science degree programs.

- ✓ Be on track for completing all high school graduation requirements
