
Registration Process for the 2022-2023 School Year

Two Cambridge Pathways:

 Students take classes within the program that most interest them - Pre-AICE or AICE

2. Students are working to earn an AICE Diploma

<u>How to</u> <u>Earn An</u> <u>AICE</u> Diploma



Total of seven credits required for Diploma

Cambridge International AS Level = one credit

Cambridge International A Level = two credits

Learners can accumulate credits for the Diploma over a 25-month period.

Why the AICE Diploma?

1. Students who earn the AICE Diploma leave RHS with a minimum of 21 college credits.

 Students who earn the AICE Diploma are eligible for highest level of Bright Futures (with required # of community service hours). GPA and SAT/ACT Scores requirements do not have to be met.

Bright Futures Academic Scholar Requirements

Regular Route	Merit Recognition Program - AICE Diploma
3.5 GPA in select courses (4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 History, 2 World Language)	No GPA requirement must be met
1330 on SAT OR 29 Composite on ACT	No SAT or ACT test score requirement must be met
100 Community Service Hours	100 Community Service Hours

AICE and Dual-enrollment
