There are limited spots available, so parents must pre-sign up here with a first come, first served approach. Sign up under your student's teacher's name for their lunchtime time slot.

#### **Guidelines:**

- Parents/Guardians or Grandparents must be on time for their child's scheduled lunchtime.
- Parents/Guardians or Grandparents must communicate with their child's teacher that will be coming to lunch on that day.
- We suggest an email that morning- the teacher will respond that they received your email.
- We cannot make changes over the phone (as this interrupts instruction).
- Parents/Guardians or Grandparents must have their driver's license and sign in at the front office. Your child will be in the hall-way in front of the cafeteria to meet you.
- A registered volunteer will monitor the lunch process.
- You will be sitting outside of the cafeteria in the commons area.

#### Parents/Guardians or Grandparents may only have lunch with their child.

- We suggest younger siblings stay home, if possible, due to limited seating.
- Please be mindful of time, your child will need to report back to the cafeteria, with their class, before the end of the lunch period to line up with their class. The registered volunteer on duty will assist with this process.
- Parents/Guardians or Grandparents must report back to the front office and sign out.
- Please do not enter the cafeteria, a teacher will assist you.
