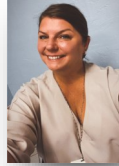

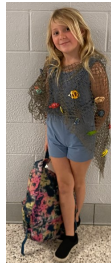

## Medication Prescription Rules

### Florida Statute 1006.062

1. A separate Permission Form must be completed for each medication given at school. Forms **MUST** be signed by the legal parent/guardian only.
2. When completing Permission Forms, please make sure that your instructions match the pharmacy label or manufacturer label
3. School Nurse will not accept a medication if the label has been altered in any way. Please **DO NOT** write on the pharmacy label
4. All medications must be in the Original Container/Box with the manufacturer or pharmacy label in place. The medication must have a valid expiration date and the prescription must be current.
5. Medication in baggies will **NOT** be accepted or administered. This includes cough drops and over the counter (OTC) medications. **NO Cough Drops allowed**, they must be checked into the clinic in original packaging and cannot be kept with student.
6. All medication will be counted upon arrival at school. Legal Parent/Guardian will initial to verify that the count is correct.
7. For your Legal Protection, please do not allow your child to transport any medication to/from school.
8. Over the counter (OTC) medications will remain in the clinic for 10 days, then, discarded. Age-appropriate doses will be given as directed by the manufacturer's label. a longer time period or a dose change is needed, written physician authorization is required.

## Parents/Guardians of Bus Riders, Please Read

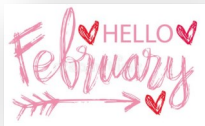
When students are new to the bus and are receiving their bus pass for the 1st time, it can take up to 2-3 weeks to get their badges. As long as they have turned in the paper bus pass they are allowed on the bus. Students should enter their district number when getting on and off the bus until a badge arrives (*bus drivers will assist if needed*).

If the students have received a bus pass this year, their badge will have already been listed and created and will not be created again. Students can use their badge from previous schools, it does not need to have the current school listed. If they say they lost it, then the school will need to submit a request for a lost badge. They only receive ONE (1) free replacement.

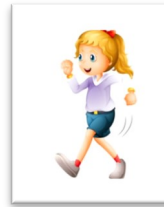
