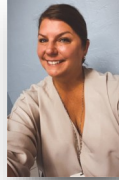

Lunch with your children at school - 2022 - 2023

Beginning September 6, we began welcoming parents/guardians to have lunch with their children on set days. Here is the scoop!

Who: Parent/guardian or grandparent (and their name must be on the registered pick-up list).

Where: Roosevelt commons area just before the cafeteria.

When: Tuesdays and Fridays ONLY- Sign up for lunch, up to 1 time per week, on the "Lunch in the Commons" Sign-Up Genius. Please do not bring other guests due to limited seating.

Note: Each class is limited to 4 slots per class. Each slot is one lunch period.

Registered Volunteers Needed: All lunch visitors will need to be escorted to and from the commons area. Use the Sign-up Genius to help escort the visitors and monitor the patio. A registered volunteer must be on the patio at all times.

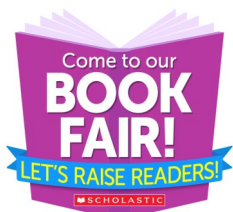
Celebrating a birthday? Be sure to plan ahead and have Mr. Devin create a birthday surprise for your child and their class! Order form link below 😊
