Meetings are held each year to review this Compact and make changes based on student needs.</p>		
<p>School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)</p>	<p>The South Alternative Learning Center data reveals that a significant number of referrals and sending offenses stem from behavioral conflicts such as verbal and physical altercations, threats, and intimidation. Conflict mediation and resolution, and positive coping strategies development will assist the students in transitioning back to their homeschool, and building and maintaining positive peer relationships.</p>	
<p>Working together for success: In the classroom</p>	<p>Teachers will maintain regular and frequent communication with parents, families, and students utilizing a variety of methods including e-mail and phone. Teachers will provide ongoing support in assisting parents in monitoring their student's progress, understanding student assessments, and building strong relationships between the families and the school. Teachers will engage students in regular classroom instruction related to conflict mediation and resolution, social emotional development, and resiliency. Students will be given the opportunity to practice skills development in real time through classroom activities, small groups, and individual interventions.</p>	
<p>Working together for success: At home</p>	<p>Parents and families will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of trainings and family engagement opportunities throughout the school year covering topics related to positive parenting, family conflict resolution, substance use prevention, mental wellness, and academic support strategies. Parents will have the ability to monitor student progress through edgenuity and FOCUS, and regular teacher contact.</p>	
<p>Working together for success: Student responsibility</p>	<p>Students will have the opportunity to participate in conflict mediation and resolution training, peer mediation, and substance use prevention counseling services as well as additional school-based supportive services focused on goal setting and planning, decision making, healthy relationships, and communication. Students will have the ability to monitor their own progress through edgenuity and FOCUS, as well as regular communication with their teacher. Students will be provided training on how to monitor their own progress.</p>	
<p>Communication: Staying informed</p>	<p>All pertinent information will be distributed in a timely manner using a variety of delivery methods to ensure all parents, families, and students are informed in a timely manner. Methods will include regular e-mail and phone contact, FOCUS communication, website and social media delivery, and through regular in person and virtual parent and family engagement events, parent conferences, and open house.</p>	
<p>Building Partnerships</p>	<p>Students will have the opportunity to participate in school based mentoring programs, school based support services related to drug and violence prevention, and mental wellness support. Parents and families will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of events, activities, and meetings to connect with teachers and staff, community partners, and other important stakeholders to better support them and their student.</p>
