In this course students explore career clusters and learn how to make informed career choices. The sixteen, national Career Clusters provide a method to organize virtually all occupations from entry to professional levels. Activities empower students to increase self-awareness and to develop the skills needed to successfully plan for postsecondary education and the workplace. Students participate in career assessments that provide individualized information about interests, aptitudes, and basic skills. Students also explore and learn about a variety of post-secondary and career opportunities. Through hands-on experiences, students study the Career and Technical Education (CTE) areas of Family & Consumer Science, Technology Education, and Business Education.
