

<u>7reshman Cohort</u> (Grades 7-9)

- Beginning in 7th grade, VAP gifted and high-achieving students participate in an accelerated curriculum that prepares them for success in Advanced Placement courses
- VAP classes are rigorous, handson, and engaging because they are taught by gifted certified teachers
- VAP students take their first AP class in 9th grade - AP Computer Science Principles
