

Before disseminating the PSAT/NMSQT scores:

Using the TNTP instructions provided in the other attachment, please set up your own College Board account (or update your account if you have one)

When you are with the students:

First, watch the 47 second video found at “How to Link Your College Board + Khan Academy Accounts - youtube

Then, assist the students in setting up and linking their College Board and Khan Academy accounts:

College Board Account:

- 1) Go to collegeboard.org
- 2) If you have an account, sign in. Most will not have an account, so we will create one. Click where it says “Don’t have an account? Sign up”

- 3) Click on “a student”
- 4) Fill out the demographic info
- 5) Confirm the following info – click each checkbox
- 6) When you confirm, you have an account!

Khan Academy Account and how to link the two:

- 1) Go to satpractice.org
- 2) Click “sign up” on the far right at the top
- 3) Fill in your date of birth
- 4) Fill in your name and the email that you used for your SAT account.
- 5) Answer the 2 questions posed – choose “A” for both answers
- 6) Onward!
- 7) Takes you to a security check
- 8) Use your created password and click the green “send” button
- 9) Continue following instructions where you are prompted to link your Khan Academy account with your College Board account.
- 10) This will take you where you can set up a practice schedule to follow to improve your SAT scores. Explore the site, but make sure that you choose a test date so that you will have the schedule created for you to follow
