Important Notes About Student Schedules

- Physical Education Electives: Students may only enroll in up to one (1) physical education period per semester.
- <u>Advanced Placement:</u> All students enrolled in an Advanced Placement course must sign the Advanced Placement Contract by **August 30, 2024**
- <u>Intensive Language Arts:</u> Students who score below grade level in state reading assessments must enroll in Intensive Language Arts.
- 2 years of JROTC satisfies the HOPE and PFA requirement
- JROTC gives you leadership opportunities on Satellite's campus and opportunity to fly drones and participate in flight simulation.
- 2 seasons of an approved sport satisfies the HOPE requirement. (HOPE Waiver needed)
- Deadline to Submit Course Request is **March 15, 2024**. Failure to submit a course request will result in a counselor created schedule.
- The deadline to modify course requests is May 24, 2024.
