### **Important Notes About Student Schedules**

- Physical Education Electives: Students may only enroll in up to one (1) physical education period per semester.
- Advanced Placement: All students enrolled in AP Human Geography must sign the Advanced Placement Contract by **August 30, 2024**
- Intensive Language Arts: Students who score below grade level in state reading assessments must enroll in Intensive Language Arts.
- AF ROTC: 2 years of JROTC satisfies the HOPE and Performing Art requirement.  
JROTC gives you leadership opportunities on Satellite's campus and opportunity to fly drones and participate in flight simulation.
- JV & Varsity Sports: 2 seasons of an approved sport satisfies the HOPE requirement. (HOPE Waiver needed)
