Volunteer hours may also be completed by helping with our Saturday evening RESPITE program

We also offer volunteer opportunities for special events; Clean-up Work-Days, Cycle Jam, Autism Awareness Festival, and Fundraisers. Helping with these events could be projects done by individual students, faith-based or Scouting groups, or classes.
