- The Satellite Academy of Fine Arts (SAFA) encourages the development of aesthetic, analytical, interpersonal, creative, and performance skills of students at all levels. This Choice Program is academically challenging, performance/technologically sound, as well as college and career driven.
- The Satellite Academy of Fine Arts has eight areas of focus: instrumental music, vocal music, theater, art, digital media, web application development, and technical design. Each CTE program provides opportunities for students to earn industry certification that can be used for employment or post-secondary educational opportunities.
- The program provides a relevant and rigorous curriculum to prepare students for the 21st-century arts community workplace as well as post-secondary opportunities. Through integration, students see relativity and form connections between art, music, literature, history, and more.
- Enrollment in the Satellite Academy of Fine Arts is based on student and parent choice, an audition/interview, placement through the Educational Program Opportunities, and a lottery.

SAFA Requirements:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA in fine art concentration, and an overall 2.5 GPA.
- Enroll SAFA English, World History, and US History honors courses. Eligible SAFA students may replace these courses with Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment level courses.
- Earn 100 hours of Community Service by end of the senior year (15 hours each semester).
- Pass Industry Certification Exams.
- Students must complete one of the following during their senior year: Advanced Placement course, portfolio, performance, or pass Industry Certification exam(s).
- Vocal, theatre, and instrumental music students only: student attendance is mandatory for all performances.
- Parent volunteer service agreement.
- Annual student and parent meeting with Academy Director to review SAFA requirements.
- Students must adhere to all district/school attendance and discipline policies.
