- ❖ Library books are checked out at the front circulation counter or the back circulation desk.
- ❖ Library books are returned to the “Book Drop” or handed to a library person.
- ❖ You should have your student ID number to check out books.
- ❖ Books have a two week checkout. You can see your due date in Destiny, online or on the bookmark we give you at check out.
- ❖ Lost or damaged books must be paid for.
- ❖ Two books at a time may be checked out for a 2 week period.

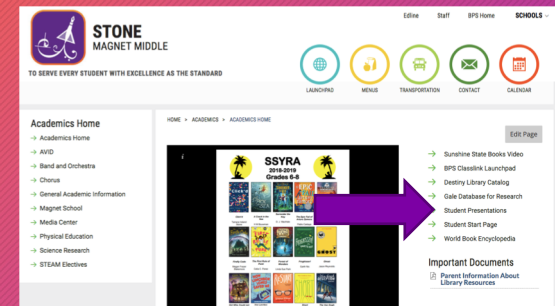
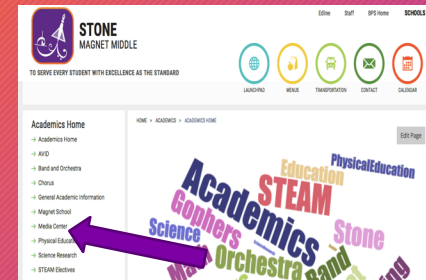
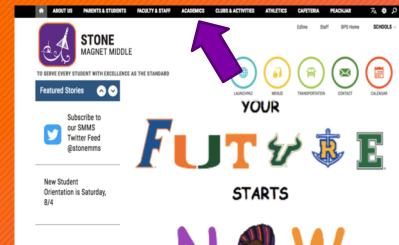


Logging on to Computers

- Go to a computer (choose one you like and stick with it)
- Top box: student id number
- Bottom box: password1
- Create new password: must be at least six characters long and has to be something you have never used for BPS ever before.
- Must be changed every NINETY days.
- Choose a base word you will remember and add the number 1. Must be a total of six characters.
- Increase the number by one each time you have to redo your password.
- EXAMPLE: “tatertots1” then in ninety days “tatertots2” then in ninety days “tatertots3”

When I Give You Control...

- You will sign in (see instructions)
- You will go to Launchpad (see instructions)
- You will click on Stone Magnet Middle Home icon
- You will click on “Academics”
- Then click on the left side “Media Center”
- Then on the right, click on “Student Presentations”
- This takes you to shared Google Drive folder.

- ALWAYS use Launchpad when you need to access anything for school.

- Go to “Finder”



- Click on “Applications” and choose “Google Chrome”



- Allow to make Google Chrome the default browser.

- Type in “Brevard Launchpad” click on the first one in the returned searches.

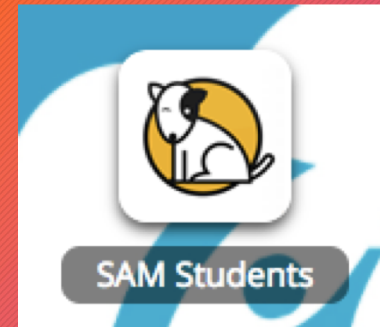

- Click on the green “add” button then “X” out of that screen.



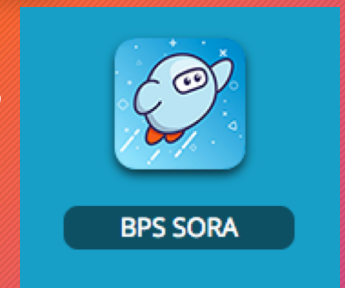

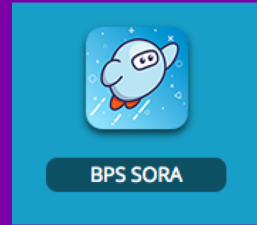
- Click on SAM Students icon.

SORA for eBooks and Audio Books

- In Launchpad, if you do not see the SORA icon, you will need to add it.
- Go to the “+” sign in the upper left of your screen.
- In the search bar, type in “bps sora” and hit the “return” key on the keyboard.
- Click on the green “add” button then “X” out of that screen.



SORA for eBooks and Audio Books



- Click on SORA icon.
- Username and Password are the same as you log into BPS Launchpad.
- Once you have logged in through BPS Launchpad, you should not have to reenter your credentials.
- You can search for eBooks and Audio Books that all the secondary schools in all of Brevard county own.
- You can also link your public library account, if you have one. Ask Ms. Maggio how to do it!

Searching for Books

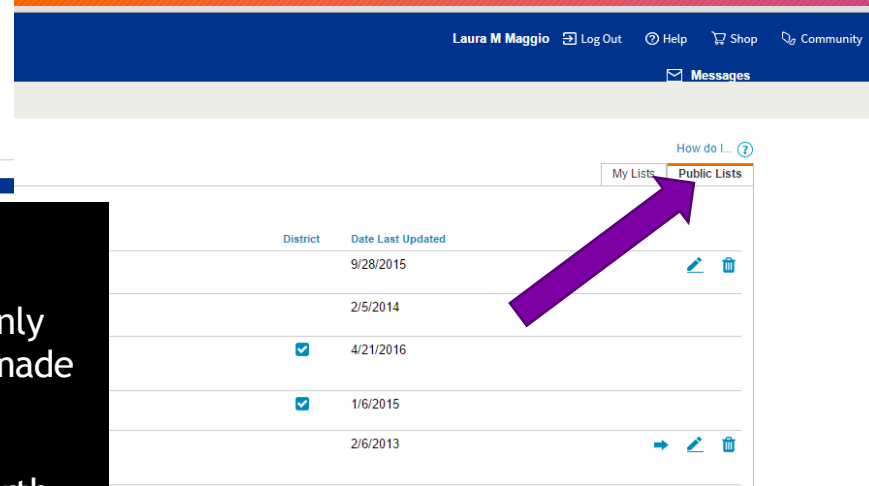
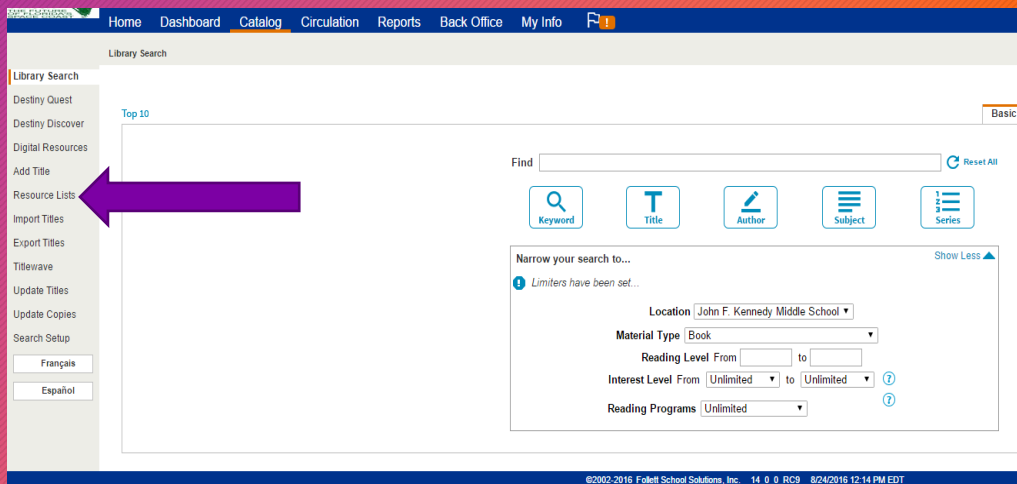
Several search options exist. “Basic” is the most common, but if you are looking for some very specific delimiters try “Power Search”.

Click on the tab to choose the type of search you want, and type pertinent information into the search bar, clicking on the appropriate icon for keyword, title, author, etc.

You can also narrow your search by the type of material, reading level, etcetera by using the drop down arrow choices.

If you go through Launchpad, you are automatically signed in!

Viewing Resource Lists

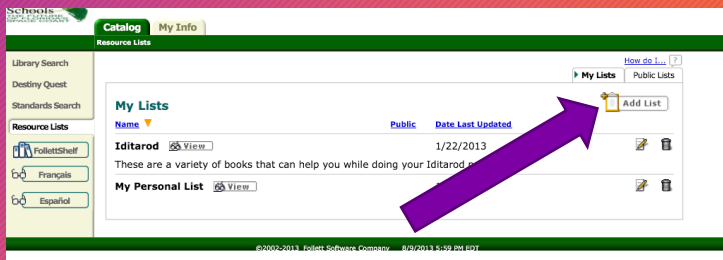


On left hand side, click on “Resource Lists”

At the top right, there are two tabs, “My Lists” where you only see lists you made and “Public Lists” where you see others made public by creator.

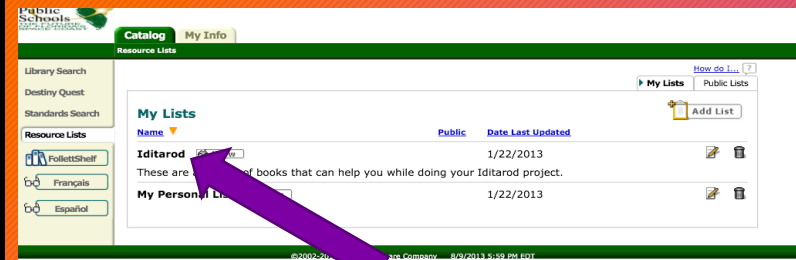
You can make yours public or private and can go back and forth so you can reuse and edit lists from year to year.

Creating Resource Lists



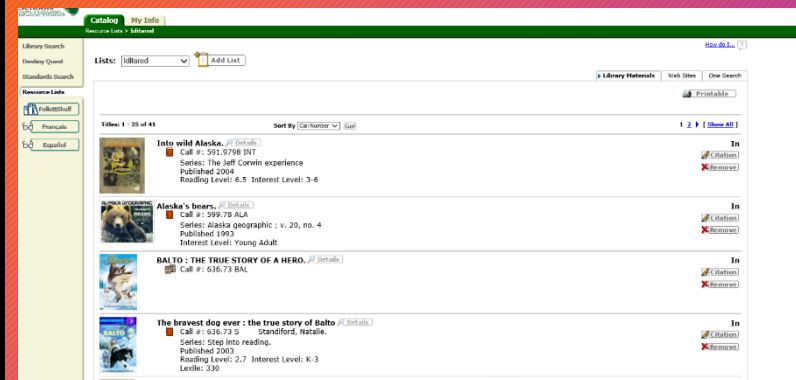
Click on the “My Lists” tab.

Reading and Checking Out

See the [Stone Edline Media Center homepage](#) for more information about loading books onto your portable device.

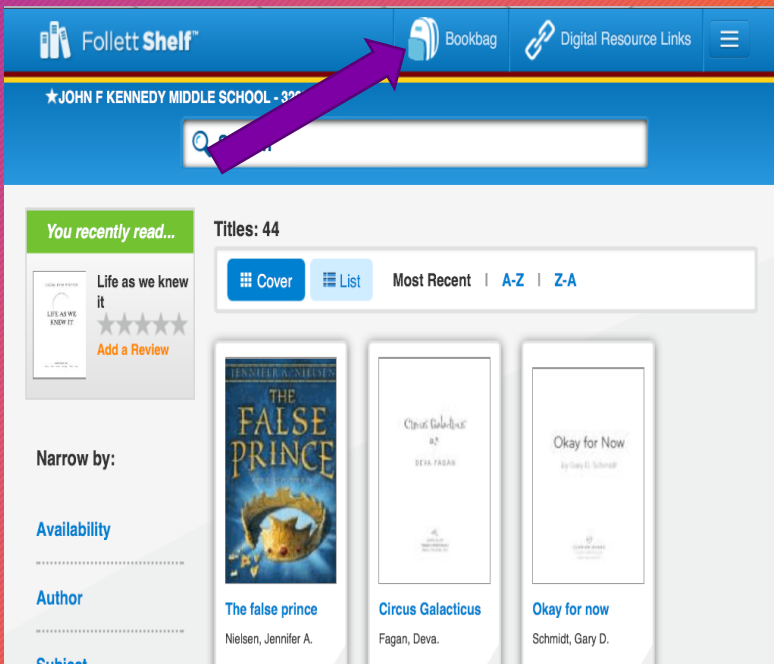
Search for and/or click on the title you want.

Login for Follett ebooks is same as Follett Destiny.

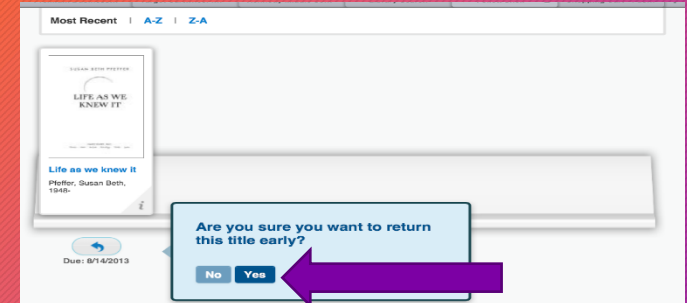
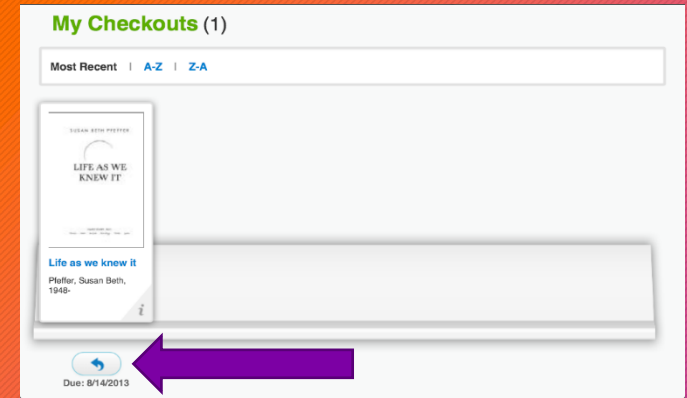
Returning an ebook
