

Saturday Research Work Day Guidelines

- Students must sign-up in advance for the time slot and teacher they will be working with. This is necessary because each teacher can only work with few students at a time and we need to know that the student is ready to conduct their experiment.
- Students should prepare in advance and have a plan for what they would like to accomplish. If possible, get the necessary supplies and equipment together the day before. Bring your log book and a printed copy of your research proposal with the experimental methods.
- Students must be dropped off and picked up at the research room (311). Parents must come inside and sign their student in and out. Students may not “wait out front” to be picked up.
- Students are to be dropped off and picked up on time. There is no supervision available on campus before or after the scheduled times.
- Stone research students only, no friends or siblings.
- Lunch – if students will be at school during lunchtime on a Saturday workday there are several lunch options: they may bring their lunch, a parent can drop off lunch or they can pay \$5.00 for two slices of pizza (cheese or pepperoni) and a soft drink (coke or sprite).
- This time is provided for serious research work; the parents of students that are not working or are disruptive will be called to pick the student up.
- Students must clean up their area before leaving.
