How to view your Child's FAST Reading and Math Assessment Results in FOCUS Parent Portal

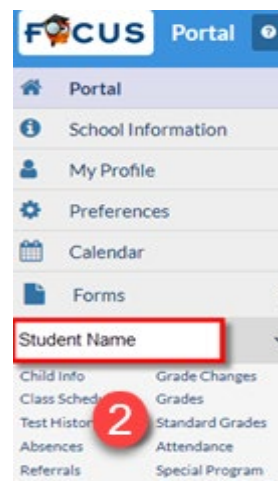
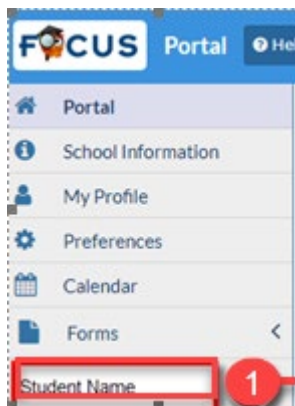
Parents can view their child's Test History (for State Assessments) from the FOCUS Parent Portal. To Login or to create a new FOCUS Parent Portal Account go to <https://www.brevardschools.org/focus>

Once successfully logged into a Parent Portal account follow the steps below:

From the Focus portal page on the left side of the screen click on the student's name to open the menu.

1. On the left side of the screen, click on your child's name to open the menu.

2. Click on **Test History** to view the test information.



3. Click on the gray triangle ► in front of the **Administration Date** column to view Test scores and additional information.

4 Scale Score:

The Scaled Score (SS) is useful for comparing student performance over time and across grades. A scaled score is calculated based on the difficulty of the questions and the number of correct responses.

5 Achievement/Performance Level:

Level 1	Level 2	Level 3	Level 4	Level 5
Inadequate: Highly likely to need substantial support for the next grade	Below Satisfactory: Likely to need substantial support for the next grade	Satisfactory: May need additional support for the next grade	Proficient: Likely to excel in the next grade	Mastery: Highly likely to excel in the next grade

Please note: State Achievement Levels are based on end-of-year (PM3) mastery of standards. FAST Reading and Math assessments are computer-adaptive tests and students may not have learned all standards assessed by the PM1 and PM 2 Testing Windows.

6 Testing Window. There are three State Progress Monitoring windows:

- PM1: Progress Monitoring Window #1 (Fall)
- PM2: Progress Monitoring Window #2 (Winter)
- PM3: Progress Monitoring Window #3 (Spring)
