- d. **Reviewed IReady data that shows all grade levels in the high growth, high performance quadrant, except 2nd. Looked at FAST data in both reading and math and compared our school to the district and state in both reading and math for grades 4-6 grades. We have a lower percentage of students scoring a level one than both the state and district. And we have a higher percentage of students scoring a level 5 than the state or district in both reading and math.**
