What is Gifted and Talented?

There is a difference

Gifted- Student has a high IQ.
Student received an education plan
(EP) after testing high on an IQ test
with a psychologist. This designation
and EP requires enrichment services
be provided by the school.

Talented- Student who is a high achiever in the classroom and on the state/county tests. (ex: all A's on report card, high score on iReady, level 5's on FSA)

Gifted and Talented Class

What do we do?

We are a hybrid class. That means the curriculum we work on meets the needs of gifted and talented kids. We do social/emotional learning for gifted students as well as long-term, out of the box projects.

For talented students, we focus on academic acceleration. We work on harder versions of the problems that they are currently doing in general education classrooms.

All students work on the same <u>curri</u>culum in class, even if they only have one of the two designations.

Why is my child in this class?

Either they have been designated as gifted or talented by school staff

Gifted Route- You, the parent, were notified that your child might be gifted through a letter from the school. You consented to testing and the school proceeded to give your child IQ tests, which they passed. You were then called into a meeting with the school psychologist, gifted teacher and ESE specialist to write an EP (Education Plan) for your child. Once a child is designated as gifted, they are always considered gifted.

But what if they didn't pass the gifted criteria?

Why is my child in this class?

Talented Route- The student was recommended by school staff to Ms. Hall, the principal. Ms. Hall analyzed students' report cards, FSA scores and iready scores from last year to determine if talented pull-out would benefit selected students.

Unlike gifted enrichment, talented enrichment is not guaranteed by the state. Therefore, students are not guaranteed a spot in the class under the talented designation. Students must continue to show classroom excellence to maintain a talented status.

Classroom Expectations

Students will...

- Check-in with homeroom teacher before coming to G&T (For morning students, be in homeroom class until 8:15. Do not show up early because no adult will be here to supervise.)
- Be respectful towards teachers and peers- everyone should feel welcomed here
- Remain seated at specified desk unless redirected to another part of the room by the teacher or refilling their water bottles at the sink.

Expectations Continued

- Ask for permission before leaving the classroom (bathroom, nurse, etc.)
- Keep phones put away from 8:15-2:45
- Display academic integrity on all assignments and assessments
- Participate in class and ask for help when it is needed- G&T is not an extra recess period. Students are expected to participate in all tasks.
- Bring backpacks and G&T folders home and back to school everyday
- Have supplies for learning(pencils, dry erase markers, paper, etc.)

- Progress Reports are for gifted students only- not talented
