I'd like to remind everyone that your school calendar has all important dates and times for school events. Please refer to that calendar often. There is one change that I would like to alert all families to and that is our Back-to-School Scholastic Book Fair has been postponed. At this time, all scheduled Book Fairs have been put on hold until further notice to ensure compliance with new Florida laws effective July 1, 2022 (H.B. 1467, H.B. 1557).

Our Before and Aftercare sign in and sign out process is different than last year. The program is now using a PIN number like in previous years to check in and check out your child/children. The kiosk to put your PIN number in, will be located inside the cafeteria. You need to park in the parking lot across from the cafeteria and come inside the cafeteria to check in/check out. You can create your PIN number on your BAS portal, EZChildTrack.
