Good Afternoon Stevenson Families!

I hope you are enjoying your summer break so far. We have been hard at work getting prepared for the upcoming school year. Our amazing custodial team has been deep cleaning the school and our wonderful front office staff has been making sure everything needed for the 21-22 school year is ready. Ms. Ward has been hard at work in the cafeteria ordering ingredients for her wonderful breakfast and lunch menu items. By the way, free breakfast and lunches will be provided to all students during the 21-22 school year.

I wanted to communicate some plans for the new school year. First, 'Welcome Back Weeks' will be from July 26th to August 5th. Stop in anytime during this timeframe to purchase needed items, verify your contact information, and receive your child's classroom placement. Remember to bring your checkbook and/or cash with you as the school can not accept credit cards. - Families are unable to walk students to classrooms
