

Late Fees


Fines are 5¢ per day for books.

A genre consisting of stories that contain strange or imaginary settings and/or characters. Stories are not true and could not ever be true. They may include imaginary worlds, fantastic creatures, or ordinary people and animals who can do extraordinary things.

A genre consisting of stories that are a type of fantasy that's based on imagined future scientific or technological advances and major social or environmental changes, frequently portraying space or time travel and life on other planets.

Realistic Fiction

Historical Fiction

A genre consisting of stories that could have actually occurred to people or animals in a believable setting. These stories resemble real life, and fictional characters within these stories react similarly to real people. These stories depict our world and our society.

A genre consisting of stories with a made-up storyline that takes place during an actual time in history. Often, the setting is real, but the characters are made up from the author's imagination.

MYSTERY




A genre consisting of stories that involve a puzzling crime or another suspenseful event dealing with unraveling of secrets which is not solved until the end of the story. A genre consisting of stories that are intended to, or has the capacity to frighten, scare, disgust, or startle its readers by inducing feelings of horror and terror.


SORT BY

Step 4: Click on 4 squares to show just the tiles.




