Content includes computer skills; digital publishing concepts and operations; layout, design, and measurement activities; digital imaging; communication, collaboration, and decision-making activities.

Cybersecurity (1 credit)



Students learn foundational skills in computer and network security, security vulnerabilities, attack mechanisms and techniques, intrusion detection and prevention, and more.

Explore careers and history of the food service industry, along with food safety manager training/ certification programs that are acceptable in Florida. Students learn using modern technology and culinary trends to prepare quality food products and present them creatively to develop advanced culinary techniques and skills.





Automotive Maintenance and
Light Repair Program
Gold Seal/AYES Program Certification
Automotive Maintenance & Light Repair 1-6 (1 credit each)

Explore career opportunities and requirements of a professional service technician. Study and service tools, equipment, shop operations, basic engine fundamentals, basic technician skills, automotive electrical systems, starting and charging systems, batteries, lighting, service suspension, steering systems, brake systems, automotive HVAC systems, engine performance systems, and automatic and manual transmission/transaxle systems.

Television Production Technology
Gold Seal/Advanced Standing Credit
Television Production 1-6 (1 credit each)



Prepare students for initial employment as tv production operators, tv broadcast technicians, camera operators, video recording engineers, and audio recording engineers. Develop skills in scriptwriting, program production, digital audio and video recording and editing operations, lighting for tv productions, interpret scripts for tv productions, and collaborate with other members of the production team to create a tv program.

CTE Bright Seal Vocational Scholars Requirements 🛠

GSV - Gold Seal Vocational Scholars

- 1. Complete 3 secondary school career credits in a single CTE program.
- 2. Achieve passing score on the Florida College Entry Level Placement Test.
- 3. Achieve minimum cumulative weighted grade point average of 3.0 on standard required courses, excluding elective courses.
- 4. Achieve minimum unweighted grade point average of 3.5 in the CTE courses.
- 5. Complete at least 30 hrs of volunteer service hrs.

GSC - Gold Seal CAPE Scholars

- 1. Five (5) postsecondary credit hours through approved CAPE industry certifications.
- 2. Complete at least 30 hrs of volunteer service hrs.

Patient Care Assisting (PSAV) Program Health Science Directed Study (0.2 credit) Basic Healthcare worker, Articulated Nursing Assistant, Advanced Home Health Aide, & Patient Care Assistant (0.5 credit each)

Prepares students for employment as cross trained nursing assistants (Patient Care Assistants, Nursing Aides and Orderlies, or Home Health Aides). This program offers a broad foundation of knowledge and skills, expanding the traditional role of the nursing assistant, for both acute and long-term care settings focusing on broad, transferable skills and stresses understanding and demonstration of the following elements of the health care industry; planning, management, finance, technical and production skills, underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues and health, safety, and environmental issues.



Dispatcher: Police, Fire, Ambulance (1.5 credit each)

Prepares students for employment as a 911 dispatcher immediately after graduation. Seniors only.
