

Different Types of Dual Enrollment Opportunities at Titusville High School

1. **On campus dual enrollment** – includes our health science dual enrollment courses: Intro to Healthcare, Medical Terminology and Patient Care (seniors only). A 2.5 GPA is required for Intro to HC and Medical Terminology and an ACT, SAT or PERT test must be completed and reading and writing scores are required. The application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
2. **Part-time dual enrollment** – off campus at EFSC: A 3.0 GPA is required, and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading and English (Writing) on the ACT, SAT or PERT. The application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
 - 1 release block = 2 dual enrollment classes
 - 2 release blocks = 4 dual enrollment classes
3. **Full-time dual enrollment (seniors only)** – off campus at any EFSC during 2nd semester only: A 3.0 GPA is required, and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading and English (Writing) on the ACT, SAT or PERT. The application process, including orientation, must be completed prior to the semester these classes begin.
 - Only for 2nd semester seniors, No classes at the high school, 4-5 dual enrollment classes
 - Must have the following high school requirements completed by the end of 1st semester of the senior year
 - 28 credits
 - Virtual course requirement
 - 3 English credits
 - 3 or 3.5 Math credits (depends on college readiness score)
 - 3/4 required Social Studies credits, unless taking American National Government
 - 3/4 required Science credits
4. **Early Admission (seniors only)** - off campus at any EFSC the entire senior year: A 3.0 GPA is required, and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading, English (Writing) **and Math** on the ACT, SAT or PERT. The application packet for Early Admission must be completed and turned into the college by their due date or the senior will not be considered for Early Admission (BPS policy). Packets available usually in Mid-March listen for announcements.
 - Only for Seniors, No classes at the high school, 4-5 dual enrollment classes each semester
 - Must have the following high school requirements completed before August 1 of your senior year:
 - 24 credits
 - Virtual course requirement
 - 3 English credits
 - 3 Math credits
 - 3 required Social Studies credits, unless taking American National Government or completing US History
 - 3 required Science credits
5. **Collegiate High School** - off campus at EFSC: A 3.0 GPA is required, and College Readiness Scores must be attained in Reading and English (Writing) on the ACT, SAT or PERT and earned in Math by the end of the junior year.
 - Must attend a Collegiate HS Orientation in 9th or 10th grade and continue on a path to reach an A.A. degree. Failing a required course for the A.A. or dropping below the GPA requirement is reason for dismissal from Collegiate High School.
 - **Only** Collegiate High School dual enrolled students are eligible for bus transportation to EFSC during 4th block.
