Testing Update:

On the dates listed below the following grade levels will participate in state mandated progress monitoring.

- Wednesday, September 6th: Grade 9 PM 1 Reading
- Thursday, September 7th: Grade 10 PM 1 Reading

Throughout the month of September, Grade 12 (Cohort 2024) and Grade 11 (Cohort 2025) students that **have not met** the ELA or Algebra 1 graduation assessment requirements will participate in the FAST Grade 10 Retake, FSA Reading/Writing Retake, or Algebra 1 Retake.

PSAT/NMSQT:

On October 4th, all students in Grade 10 will participate in the PSAT.

- Any Grade 11 or Grade 12 student that has yet to meet the Algebra 1 graduation assessment will be required to take the PSAT in an attempt to earn a concordant score.
- Grade 11 students are eligible to receive National Merit distinctions and scholarships through taking the PSAT/NMSQT. Grade 11 students may pay \$18 (CASH ONLY) and participate in this scholarship opportunity. See Mrs. Callahan in room 1-136 to sign up and make payment by August 25th.

Student Parking: Student parking hang tags have arrived! All students must display a 2023-2024 parking hang tag either by their rearview mirror or on their dashboard by Tuesday, August 22. To buy a hang tag, students should bring a valid driver's license, vehicle registration, and \$20 cash (no bill larger than a \$20 bill) to Ms. Desjardins in the Media Center before school, after school, or during lunch. **Students who park on campus after August 22 without a parking hang tag will receive a \$5 fine that will be charged to their Obligations list.**

ID Badge Policy: Students must always <u>wear</u> their ID badges while on campus. Every student will receive an ID Badge and lanyard at registration. Students who lose their ID Badge will have to purchase a new one through the Attendance Office for \$5.00.
