This agreement explains how families and teachers will work together to make sure all students reach grade-level standards. Meetings are held each year to review this Compact and make changes based on student needs.

School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)

As a result of the implementation of Reveal Math and Ed Gems along with the implementation of math intervention, Turner will increase grade level proficiency on the FAST PM3 in math by 15%. As a result of standards based instruction and implementation of Benchmark and SAVVAS and ELA intervention, Turner will increase grade level proficiency on FAST PM3 in ELA by 15%.

Working together for success: In the classroom

Teachers will plan and provide high-quality standards-based lessons that enable students to meet the state’s academic achievement standards. Teachers will provide parents with reports on student’s progress through interim reports, report cards, FOCUS and Progress Monitoring reports as needed.

Working together for success: At home

Families will ensure that their child attends school regularly, arrives on time and is prepared to learn. They will encourage good study habits, use the provided support for homework and discuss daily learning. Families will communicate with teachers, attend conferences, and review their child’s work. They will contact the school as needed to monitor their child’s progress.

Working together for success: Student responsibility

Students will share the responsibility to improve academic achievement, come prepared for class, complete classwork and homework assignments. Students will monitor their learning, ask for help when needed and believe they can and will learn.

Communication: Staying informed

Teachers will provide parents with frequent reports on their child’s progress, using multiple outlets to communicate school information. Parents will maintain current contact information and update, when necessary, stay informed about their child’s education, and check daily for information sent home from school and respond if necessary.

Building Partnerships

Teachers will involve parents in planning and improving the Title I programs, including the Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) through the School Advisory Committee meetings and through Title I meetings. Parents will actively communicate with their child’s teacher, promptly respond to messages and reports, and attend meetings (virtual/in person). Students will take their Thursday folder home each week and review progress with their parents/guardians.
